# Registration Fee

The Registration Fee is a non-refundable per child processing fee of \$150 for returning families (or \$100 if paid by March 30) that secures a space for your child(ren) for the coming year. <u>A student may not start school until this fee is paid in full</u>. This fee is non-refundable and must be paid in full by June 15, 2021. Registration for returning families paid by March 30 receives a \$50 discount. (The early Bird Registration Fee can be divided over March and April via SMART tuition for returning families).

- \$100 (early bird) per child Registration Fee for returning students due by March 30, 2021
- \$150 per child Registration Fee for returning students due by June 15th, 2021
- \$125 Registration Fee per student for new families

# <sup>1</sup>Books and Materials Fee

The Books and Materials Fee is a non-refundable per child fee of \$300 that covers the purchase of textbooks,<sup>2</sup> online resources and other materials used in the classroom throughout the year. <u>A</u> <u>Student may not start school until this fee is paid in full.</u> This fee is non-refundable and must be paid in full by June 15, 2021. (Current families may spread this fee via SMART over March, April, May and June).

# Monthly Tuition

- Tuition payments are from <u>July</u> through June (12 months).
- Junior Kindergarten half day runs from 7:40 am Noon

# Tuition Discounts:

- If a current family refers a new family to the school and they enroll, the current family receives \$200 toward their tuition. The new family must list another family as a reference on their application. This will be applied to the family's account in May and the new family must stay for at least two months.
- An additional discount is available to both the family who refers and the family who registers through the Parent Referral Program sponsored by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. To register, go to: CatholicEd.com/Refer.
- Families who choose to pay full tuition costs for the year receive a \$100 discount if paid in full before the 1st day of school.

#### Additional Fees

#### Please note that all fees are nonrefundable

- Out of Parish Fee--\$250
  - The Parish provides much assistance to the school over the course of the year as well as provides aid for many families. Because the school is reliant on this support, it is imperative that the school families support the parish. If you are not a participating parishioner, there will be a fee charged to your account in May 2021. To ensure you do not get charged this fee, you have from the time you register through April to become an active parishioner, regularly submitting donations in the Mass collections equating to the fee. If you do not participate in the collections at all, the total fee will be charged to your account. If you do participate, but do not meet the minimum (\$250), you will be charged the balance.
- Sacraments Fee (2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Only\*)
  - \$100 due by August 15th, 2021
  - \*This fee is also for any new/incoming students in Grades 3-8 who have not yet made the Sacraments of Reconciliation or Communion.
  - This fee is nonrefundable
- SMART Tuition Fee
  - \$50 billed on the first month every school year
  - This fee is nonrefundable
- Graduation Fee (8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Only)
  - \$100 due by August 15th, 2021
  - This fee is nonrefundable
- Athletic Fees
  - Fees are determined per sport/activity at the start of each season.

- In Office Payment Fee
  - If a family chooses to pay tuition with checks, money orders, etc... or other items that need to be processed by the office staff, a \$50 fee will be applied to the first month of their payment plan
  - This fee is nonrefundable

# Service Hours

Each family is required to complete 30 service hours per school year. If service hours are not completed by the end of the year, families will be billed at \$15 an hour. Donations designated by the school may be accepted in lieu of service hours at a rate of \$20 per hour.

Families may opt out of Service Responsibilities by paying a flat fee of \$450 (which is due by September 30, 2021).

# Mandatory Fundraisers:

# Each Student:

- Is required to raise net funds during the school year from among designated fundraising events during the year (see tuition chart for breakdown of the family fundraising commitment). You may choose to place all your efforts in a single fundraiser (e.g. Fitness Challenge) or spread your efforts across two or three of the designated fundraising events.
- Families may opt out of the above by paying the equivalent of their fundraising commitment by September 30, 2021.

# Each Family:

- Is required to sell 2 books of raffle tickets (\$50) for the Parish Feria event.
- Is required to sell 2 books of raffle tickets (\$50) for Tardeada.

# Tuition Assistance:

Tuition assistance is available to qualifying families. Current families who wish to request tuition assistance must complete the following steps by the assigned dates in order to be considered for tuition assistance.

- ALL families applying for assistance must first complete the CEF application process by the deadline (as designated by the CEF office).
- Families requesting additional assistance beyond CEF for 2021-2022 must complete the SMART aide application process by April 15, 2021 (or at registration for new families).
- Families requesting additional assistance beyond CEF must submit a letter of request to the school outlining their financial need by April 15, 2021 (or at time of registration for new families).
