

# St. Marianne School—Family Obligations 2020-2021

### Registration Fee

The Registration Fee is a non-refundable per child processing fee of \$150 that secures a space for your child for the coming year. Registration for returning families paid by March 30, 2020, receive a \$50 discount. The early Bird Registration Fee can be divided over February and March via SMART tuition for returning families. A student may not start school until this fee is paid in full. This fee is non-refundable and must be paid in full by June 20, 2020.

- \$100 (early bird) per child Registration Fee for returning students due by March 30, 2020
- \$150 per child Registration Fee for returning students due by June 20th, 2020
- \$125 Registration Fee per student for new families

#### **Books and Materials Fee**

The Books and Materials Fee is a non-refundable per child fee of \$350 that covers the purchase various materials used in the classroom throughout the year<sup>1</sup>. A Student may not start school until this fee is paid in full. This fee is non-refundable and must be paid in full by June 20, 2020. (Current families may spread this fee via SMART over March, April, May and June).

### **Monthly Tuition**

- Tuition payments are from <u>July</u> through May (11 months).
- Junior Kindergarten half day runs from 7:40 am Noon

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Books and Materials fee covers academic records & transcripts, student accident insurance, annual DCS fee, administrative costs, postage, paper goods, bathroom and cleaning supplies, textbooks, online materials, classroom and office supplies, STAR assessments, Accelerated Reader subscriptions, SchoolSpeak Services, technology equipment and maintenance, high speed internet and wifi, subscriptions to academic resources, class and cultural celebrations, etc.

# **Tuition Discounts:**

- If a current family refers a new family to the school and they enroll, the current family receives \$200 toward their tuition. The new family must list another family as a reference on their application. This will be applied to the family's account in May and the new family must stay for at least three months.
- An additional discount is available to both the family who refers and the family who registers through the Parent Referral Program sponsored by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. To register, go to: CatholicEd.com/Refer.
- Families who choose to pay full tuition costs for the year receive a \$100 discount if paid in full before September 30, 2020.

# **Additional Fees**

#### Please note that all fees are nonrefundable

- Active/Inactive Parishioner Fee--\$250
  - The Parish provides much assistance to the school over the course of the year as well as provides aid for many families. If you are not a participating parishioner, there will be a fee charged to your account in May 2020. To ensure you do not get charged this fee, you have from the time you register through April to become an active parishioner, regularly submitting donations in the Mass collections equating to the fee. If you do not participate in the collections at all, the total fee will be charged to your SMART account. If you do participate, but do not meet the minimum (\$250), you will be charged the balance.
- Sacraments Fee (2nd Grade Only\*)
  - \$100 due in August, 2020 (with SMART payment).
  - \*This fee is also for any new/incoming students in Grades 3-8 who have not yet made the Sacraments of Reconciliation or Communion.
  - This fee is nonrefundable
- SMART Tuition Fee
  - \$50 billed on the first month every school year
  - This fee is nonrefundable
- **Graduation Fee** (8th Grade Students Only)
  - \$100 due in August, 2020 (with SMART payment).
  - This fee is nonrefundable
- Athletic Fees
  - Fees are determined per sport/activity at the start of each season.
- Additional fundraising commitments apply when students participate in extracurricular activities, such as Athletics, Choir, Academic Decathlon, etc.

## **Service Hours**

Each family is required to complete 30 service hours per school year (25 to the school in general and 5 to the School Tardeada in May). If service hours are not completed by May 30, families will be billed at \$15 an hour for the balance. Donations to the school may be accepted in lieu of service hours at a rate of \$15 per hour (as approved by the

principal). Families may opt out of Service Responsibilities by paying a fee of \$400 (by September 30, 2020) or \$450 after September 30 and before April 30, 2021.

### **Mandatory Fundraisers:**

# **Each Student:**

• Is required to raise and collect a minimum in <u>net</u> funds during the school year from among a fall fundraising event, Scrip and the Annual School Fitness Challenge (see table above for breakdown). For example, you may choose to place all your efforts in a single fundraiser (e.g. Fitness Challenge) or spread your efforts across two or three of the designated fundraising events.

# **Each Family:**

- Is required to sell 2 books of raffle tickets (\$50) for the Parish Feria event.
- Is required to sell 2 books of raffle tickets (\$50) for School Tardeada.
- Is required to purchase 1 Tardeada ticket (appx. Value \$45, actual price TBD)

### **Tuition Assistance:**

Tuition assistance is available to qualifying families. Current families who wish to request tuition assistance must complete the following steps by the assigned dates in order to be considered for tuition assistance.

- ALL families applying for tuition assistance must complete the CEF application process by the deadline in April.
- Families requesting additional assistance beyond CEF for 2020-2021 must complete the Smart aid application process by May 1, 2020.
- Families requesting additional assistance beyond CEF must submit a letter of request to the school by May 1st, 2020, outlining their financial need.
