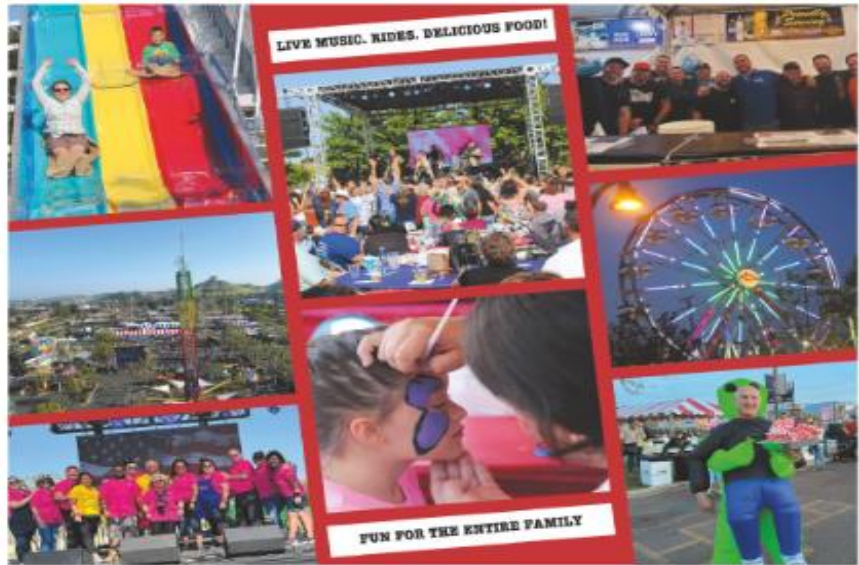



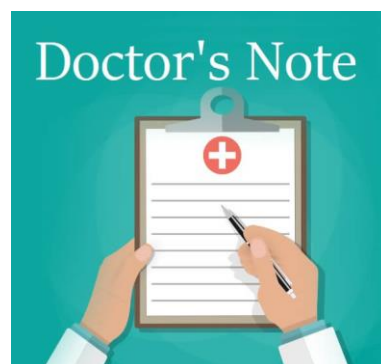

John 15:1-8

REFLECTING THE WORD

Our children desire a close and loving relationship with us. They do not desire things, but rather our time with them. They want us to put away technology and focus on connecting with them. Their greatest desire is to be in relationship. Jesus invites us to remain in him, to be a close and loving relationship with him. Jesus asks us to stay close to him. Consider how our children's desire for closeness with us can serve as a reminder of the closeness the Lord calls us to with himself.

.....ON THE WAY TO MASS.....

What does it mean to remain? We will hear this word often at Mass today. Listen for this word and think about why Jesus says it so often.

ON THE WAY HOME FROM MASS.....

We have already listened to his voice and come to him. Now he asks us to remain, to stay with him. How do we do so?

LIVING THE WORD

We know that a grapevine produces grapes, from which come grape jelly, grape juice, and even grape wine. Jesus is the true vine and we are the branches. If the life and love of the Holy Spirit are inside us, what will be visible on the outside? Will others be able to see by what we do and by what we say that the life and love of God is inside us? Enjoy a grape-inspired snack and talk about how you see each family member bearing fruit.
