





# **REFLECTING THE WORD**

Our children desire a close and loving relationship with us. They do not desire things, but rather our time with them. They want us to put away technology and focus on connecting with them. Their greatest desire is to be in relationship. Jesus invites us to remain in him, to be n a close and loving relationship with him. Jesus asks us to stay close to him. Consider how our children's desire for

closeness with us can serve as a reminder of the closeness the 1 ord calls us to with himself.

What does it mean to remain? We will hear this word often at Mass today. Listen for this word and think about why Jesus says it so often.
