First, Palm Sunday. **The Passion proclamations were so well done by lectors who practiced and prepared for weeks.** All of us in the pews received that beautiful proclamation, some with tears in their eyes. ## REFLECTING ON THE WORD

While few of us have daily experience with sheep, we can easily grasp the concept of staying close to the one who makes us feel safe and whose voice we recognize. In fact, that's one of the foundational lessons of childhood! As parents, we see this when the child most likely to dart away in public comes crying back after they've tripped or had a brief flash of feeling lost. In healthy relationships, there's an invisible tether of trust and love between parent and child, shepherd and sheep. It's not about dominance and blind submission, but a relationship born out of trust in the one who has proven his goodness. Children are keenly aware of their dependence, but as we grow older our experience with the world fractures our trust and the image of the Good Shepherd becomes more difficult to hold on to. Do you recognize his voice? What would it take for you to believe that he holds you tenderly in his hands?
