



# Keep Reading All Summer!

Did you know... students who read at least 15 minutes a day over the summer vacation demonstrate greater academic gains on the STAR test than those who do not read or read inconsistently?

In order to ensure all of our students have this advantage, summer reading is **MANDATORY** for **all** students entering **grades 2 – 8**.

## Students entering 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

Earn **4** Accelerated Reader Points

## Students entering 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade

Earn **5** Accelerated Reader Points

## Students entering 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

Earn **6** Accelerated Reader Points

## Students entering 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

Earn **7** Accelerated Reader Points

## Students entering 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

Earn **8** Accelerated Reader Points

## Students entering 7<sup>th</sup> Grade

Earn **9** Accelerated Reader Points

## Students entering 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

Earn **10** Accelerated Reader Points



Students attending Summer School will complete this requirement in summer school.

Students not in summer school will read independently over the summer and then may wait and take these AR tests during the first two weeks of school in August - OR – for those who do not wish to wait... students may drop by in July during summer school hours or in August during office hours to take the AR test. Ms. Lloyd, or one of the teachers will assist you in logging in to test.
