

Holy Trinity School 2017 - 2018

We are so excited about the changes taking place at HTS this summer! As we have announced – working with Shea Family Charities, all of the contractors and sub-contractors is impacting our start date – to ensure that the project is complete our school is ready – we have set a start date of **Tuesday, September 5th (the day after the Labor Day Holiday!)**. Our first day will be a 1pm dismissal and we will go full days for the rest of the week. Several families have asked how this will impact our closing of school date... while we have not yet completed our calendar, I am confident we will still finish mid-June without any problem. Remember – until a few years ago, all schools started after Labor Day and finished mid-June. This year – our teachers will do most of their Professional Development days before school starts – meaning fewer interruptions to the “regular” school year! We will publish our final calendar just as soon as we have it completed. Thank you for your patience.

- ✓ All students in all grades will be issued a standard homework assignment book and home/school communication folder. The fee for this was included in your registration fee. These **must** be used by **all students**. No exceptions or substitutions. This will enable us to teach important study skills.
- ✓ Pens, pencils, erasers and sharpeners that are toy-like or are decorated in a way that could be distracting, are **not** allowed. Pens that have multiple colors (like the Bic 4 color click pen) and mechanical pencils are **not** allowed. Any item that is brought to school that is not specifically on the supply list or requested by the teacher may be confiscated by the teacher or administration.
- ✓ Please be sure that your child's homework/study area is well stocked. In addition to pens, pencils, and paper, students will often need access to a dictionary, thesaurus, or Bible
- ✓ **PLEASE** carefully mark **all** uniform clothing items and **all** supplies with your child's name and grade. Lost items cannot be returned unless they are clearly labelled.
- ✓ Generally speaking, the supplies listed will last only part of the year. Pencils, pens, paper, crayons etc. **will need to be replenished throughout the year**. Stock up now during back to school sales so that you will have the items on hand when needed.
- ✓ The school will gladly accept donations of **letter size copy paper (color or white)**. In order to receive proper credit for your donation, please turn in your paper with receipt to the front office.
- ✓ If you have any questions or concerns about supplies or dress code, please ask. We are here to help you!
